4. Matters Arising from the Minutes

Technical Work Updates

Wellhead Protection Area-E Delineations:

The GIS/Database Specialist gave a PowerPoint presentation explaining the methodology used to delineate a more accurate wellhead protection area (WHPA-E) zone. More recent Southwestern Ontario Orthophotography Project (SWOOP) imagery, combined with updated stream networks and more accurate 3-dimensional digital elevation models reduced most WHPA-E zones substantially.

Threat Counts:

The Program Supervisor gave a PowerPoint presentation indicating that the total number of threats in the Region has been significantly reduced due to: the removal of the Walkerton nitrate issue; dense non-aqueous phase liquids (DNAPLs) no longer being assigned a threat designation to residential properties; improvements in knowledge of areas serviced by sewers; better information

respecting fuel activities; and recalculation of WHPA-E areas with up-to-date information and technology.

Waste Disposal Threats of Small Quantities:

The Project Manager reviewed the Waste Disposal Information Sheet distributed at the meeting and advised that this information was requested at the previous SPC meeting relating to definitions and kinds of activities involved.

The Project Manager reviewed the calendar of events respecting public consultation and the resubmission of the Updated Proposed Source Protection Plan and Revised Assessment Report to the MOE. Two working group meetings have been scheduled for Tuesday, December 2, 2014 at the Chesley Fire Hall: the Planning Officials Working Group from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon; and the Agricultural & Rural Working Group from 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.

The meeting recessed for lunch at 12:15 p.m. and reconvened at 1:05 p.m.

The Project Manager referred to discussion points and possible changes to the Proposed Source Protection Plan as well as copies of Chapter 6 of the PSPP, both of which were distributed to the members at the meeting. Items were discussed by the members and suggestions for amendments were received.
