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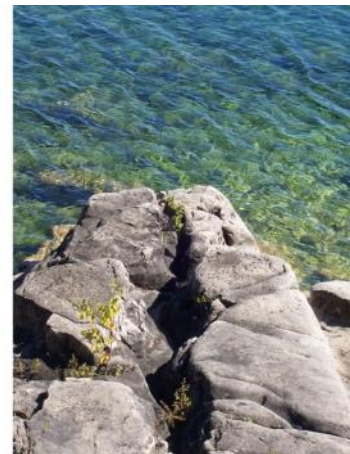
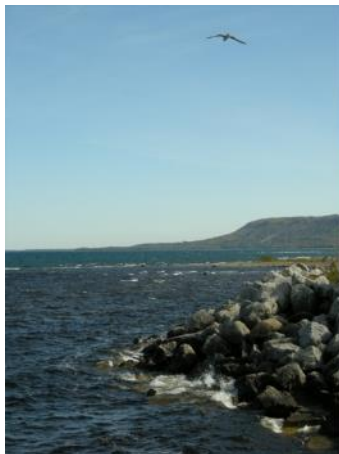


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Source Protection Plan:

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Effective Date and General Authority

This Source Protection Plan(Plan) applies to the Saugeen Valley Source Protection Area, Grey Sauble Source Protection Area and Northern Bruce Peninsula Source Protection Area as designated in Ontario Regulation 284/07. The effective date of the Saugeen, Grey Sauble, Northern Bruce Peninsula Source Protection Region Plan is **July 1, 2016**. As of this date the policies in this Plan have legal effect as provided by the *Clean Water Act, 2006*.

Policies generally apply to all three Source Protection Areas unless otherwise stated.
